It also allows support managers to send an attendance message should your child be absent. This will replace the Friday text which I know you find really useful and informative.

The app is called 'Schoolcal' and we aim to launch it on Monday 27th February.

On Monday 27th February you will receive an e-mail from 'notifications@schoolcal.co.uk' with Belmont School as the subject field, please follow the instructions in the e-mail to set up the app. If we don't have an up-to-date e-mail address for you, you will receive a text message from Belmont with a link to sign up and a code to use in order to activate the app.

Uniform

The up to date uniform leaflet can be found under the students tab of the website to remind you about what the school uniform is. The vast majority of our students are in full and correct uniform which looks immaculate and smart; our students wear it with pride. However, a small minority are letting the school down by wearing trainers, incorrect trousers and/or forgetting to wear a tie; this non-uniform will not be tolerated. Not only is it unfair for the vast majority for our students, it is also against our uniform expectations.
