ASSESSMENT

Current grades are measured using a 9-1 scale and represent a student's current performance in each subject. Students in Year 10 & 11 also receive an End of Key Stage Predicted Grade, which indicates what their final grade is likely to be at the end of Year 11, based on current performance.
